# Fee Liability 2023/2024 academic year

## Cancellation, Deferral, Intermision and Transfer

Your fee liability on Cancellation, Deferral, Intermision and Transfer is based on the Annual Tuition Fee for your entire Course as set out in the table below regardless of the instalment plan you have chosen

### Cooling off period

Students can cancel their courses within 14 days of acceptance (the 'cooling off period').

If you cancel during the cooling off period and before your Course start date, you will not be liable for your Annual Tuition Fee and your Deposit will be refunded.

If you cancel during the cooling off period but your course has already started, The University of Law can charge for materials provided and a reasonable pro-rata fee.

### No Annual Fee Liability

If you cancel on or before the date relevant to your Course Duration and Year of Study below you will not be liable for your Annual Tuition Fee. However, if you cancel after the cooling off period your Deposit will not be refunded.
